Medium of instruction: English

Text-book recommended for the Course:

Kenopanishad by Swami Sarvanandaji, published by Ramakrishna Math, Chennai (with word-for-word meaning, running translation, notes based on Sri Shankaracharya's commentary).

Reference book: Upanishads by Swami Nikhilanandaji, originally published from New York Vedanta Society, USA and now published in India by Advaita Ashrama, Mayavati, Himalayas (available at the Kolkata branch of Advaita Ashrama at Dehi Entally Road, Kolkata)

(Note: Both of these books will be displayed on the screen during the class).

Course Instructor: Swami Atmapriyananda, Pro-Chancellor & Secretary, Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Educational and Research Institute (Deemed to be University as declared by the Government of India under University Grants Commission Act, 1956), Belur Math, West Bengal.
